

**Red Flags for Pediatric Infectious Diseases Encountered in the School Setting:
A Course for School Nurses**

Program Description: This program will review the most common pediatric infectious diseases and “red flags” of physical assessment that school nurses should be aware of in order to assess and triage ill children in the school setting. We will review basic physical assessment of the school age child in relation to body systems, and practice exam skills such as otoscopy, cranial nerve exams, and teen health history taking.

- Identify background, epidemiology, signs and symptoms, treatment and guidance for the most common pediatric infectious diseases.
- Understand basic physical assessment of the school age child
