

## **Time is Brain: Managing Chronic Neurological Conditions**

**Learning Objectives:** At the end of this program, participants will be able to:

- Review cranial anatomy, cerebral circulation, and the general organization of the brain.
- Apply the elements of the nursing process to the care of the patient with chronic neurological conditions.
- Identify signs and symptoms associated with stroke and other common chronic neurological conditions.
- Interpret the epidemiology and management of stroke and TIA
